## SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM SPONSORED BY THE PRAIRIE ENTHUSIASTS-SOUTHWEST CHAPTER DEADLINE: MARCH 28, 2022

### RULES AND ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

- 1. Applicants must be interested in or currently pursuing studies in the fields of conservation or environmentalism **and** one of the following:
  - A resident or former resident of the aforementioned WI Counties or,
  - Currently enrolled in a college or other institution of higher learning in the aforementioned WI Counties
- 2. The committee will withdraw the scholarship for any applicant who does not enroll in a conservation and environmental field. The scholarship will be paid directly to the student upon successful completion of their first college or tech school semester. Official proof of first or previous semester full time enrollment and proof of full-time enrollment for the following semester of studies are required. This information must be sent to the designated SW TPE board member postmarked no later than March 28, 2022.
- 3. This is not a loan and will not have to be paid back.
- 4. Age, gender, race, religion, or physical disability is not a basis of determination of eligibility.
- 5. Applications and supporting documentation not submitted on the correct form, incomplete, filled out incorrectly, or not submitted by the deadline will automatically be disqualified from the selection process.
- 6. It is the responsibility of the applicant to make sure that all of the necessary requirements are met, and all documentation is submitted by the deadline.
