Students who attend *Badger State* are considered to have strong leadership and character traits. Being a *Badger State* delegate or alternate looks good on college applications and resumes and opens the door to scholarship possibilities.

Delegates will be sponsored by local legions and Auxiliaries, so there is not a personal cost to the student. The Riverdale School District is fortunate in that the American Legion and Auxiliary Posts of Muscoda sponsors at least one boy and girl and that the former Blue River Post set aside funding to sponsor a boy and a girl each year. In addition students are chosen as alternates. Alternates step in when a delegate is unable to attend Badger State.
