Community Memorial Scholarship

The mission of The Community Players of Southwestern Wisconsin, Inc., is not only to create community-based performances, but to educate our community of Southwestern Wisconsin. With that in mind, we provide a \$500 scholarship to students enrolling in higher education who wish to major or minor in the performing arts. It is Community Player's hope that this scholarship will aid the development of artists and future leaders in the performing arts.

This scholarship was formed in 2010 after the loss of a longtime Community Players member, Corey Bobb. He deeply loved theatre and music, and inspired others with his passion. Before he passed, Corey dreamed of becoming a music teacher so that he could help others develop their passion for the performing arts. This scholarship is in honor of his memory and the memory of many other former Community Players who shared his passion.

One applicant will receive a \$500 scholarship check to be used for tuition-related expenses at an accredited college (this includes technical colleges and conservatories) after the conclusion of the fall semester. Community Players will make the check out to the educational institution for their deposit only.

Students who grew up in or currently attend schools in Richland, Sauk, Iowa, Grant, Crawford, Vernon, Monroe, and Juneau counties are qualified to apply. Special consideration will be given to students who have been involved in past Community Players productions. A student can receive this scholarship more than once, but special consideration will be given to students who have never received this scholarship.

To be Eligible for the Scholarship:

- 1.) Must be attending or about to attend an accredited college. Technical colleges and conservatories are included.
- **2.)** Must have grown up in *or* currently attend schools in Richland, Sauk, Iowa, Grant, Crawford, Vernon, Monroe, or Juneau county.
- **3.)** Must have a 2.0 or higher cumulative GPA after the upcoming fall semester at the accredited college.
- **4.)** Must have a major or minor in the performing arts. Community Players *will consider* other art areas such as the visual arts and creative writing. There is no harm in applying.

What to Submit:

Please make sure the following materials are submitted (typed if possible):

- 1.) Application Form
- 2.) One-Page Essay (Succinctly Explain Why You are Eligible and Deserve the Scholarship)
- 3.) Most Current Official Transcript (High School or College)

Applications without the form, essay, and academic records will be disqualified. Letters of recommendation are optional, but highly advised. If selected, the scholarship winner will be asked to provide a current photo for Community Players of Southwestern Wisconsin's program promotion. All mailed applications must be postmarked no later than May 30. All emailed applications must be submitted no later than 11:59 p.m. Central Time on May 30.

Selected applicants will be notified via mail no later than July 31.

Selected applicants will need to provide Community Players with evidence of completion of the fall semester at their accredited college (the cumulative GPA must be 2.0 or higher). Selected applicants must also submit proof of registration for the next semester at the accredited college. A transcript with next semesters enrollment classes listed will verify both conditions. **This information must be provided by the second Friday in January at the latest.** Please contact Community Players before that date if an extension is needed. The \$500 check will be sent to selected applicants immediately after this information is reviewed.
