

2022 SWEEP SCHOLARSHIP

SWEEP (Southwestern Wisconsin Educational Environment Professionals) is offering multiple scholarships to graduating seniors in the amount of 2-\$150, \$200 and \$500. Each high school can nominate one student to be considered for this scholarship.

QUALIFICATIONS

- The SWEEP Scholarship will be awarded to a student who consistently works hard to maximize
 his or her effort, whose accomplishments reflect the grit and determination to succeed. Grades
 and class rank are not primary considerations in selecting the scholarship recipient.
- 2. The student must be accepted to attend a technical college or two year university.

SELECTION OF THE NOMINEE

Each teacher will be given the opportunity to nominate one student who fits the above qualifications. Each nomination shall be supported by the teacher's rationales for making the nomination. The principal in each school will be responsible for developing the selection process for determining the schools' nominee.

SELECTION OF THE SCHOLARSHIP RECIPIENT

The scholarship recipient will be selected by the members of SWEEP upon review of all nominees submitted by member schools. Applications must be completed and submitted by April 10, 2022.

PAYMENT OF SCHOLARSHIP

The scholarship recipient will be paid upon submitting a copy of first semester college grades and proof of enrollment in second semester classes to the school counselor of the recipient's school. The school counselor will then notify SWEEP that the recipient has met requirements and is due payment.
